DEFINITION

To determine which level to enter, competitors should go by the highest level/grade of the competitors. For example: for players with three in grade 5 and one in grade 8 – they must enter the Junior level.

Elementary Level: Competitors studying at levels/grades **1 to 5** for their specific instrument.

Junior Level: Competitors studying at levels/grades **6 to 9** for their specific instrument.

Senior Level: Competitors studying at levels/grades **10 and Above** for their specific instrument.

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

Competitors may only perform **one (1) selection**.

The maximum performance times are listed below:

Elementary Level: **Twenty (20) minutes**

Junior Level: **Twenty (20) minutes**

Senior Level: **Twenty-five (25) minutes**

There is no minimum performance time.

Accurate performance times must be included on the entry form. Do not guess timings.
